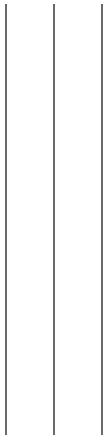

SAFE-T PROGRAM™

What Is SAFE-T?

The SAFE-T Program™ is a comprehensive health education and violence prevention program designed specifically for middle school communities. The goal of the SAFE-T Program is to prevent sexual victimization and promote healthy relationships in early adolescents.

Why Do We Need SAFE-T At Our School?

The State of Vermont requires that our schools provide safe and harassment-free learning environments for all students. The SAFE-T Program is an effective way to meet the State of Vermont's guidelines for Comprehensive Health Education Curriculum for Middle Schools. The SAFE-T Program also meets the core curriculum requirements of Vermont's *Framework of Standards and Learning Opportunities*. The SAFE-T Program meets the Safe and Drug Free Schools criteria for approved strategies.



perpetrator prevention within middle school communities. Students learn about risk factors and prevention skills and practice communication skills, empathy and peer protection from three different perspectives: that of victim, perpetrator and bystander. This comprehensive approach emphasizes that everyone has a role to play in the prevention of sexual abuse, harassment, cyberbullying, and school violence.

How Does SAFE-T Work?

The SAFE-T Program provides middle school students, educators, support staff, parents/guardians and community members with the tools for creating a respectful learning environment for all students. The SAFE-T Program's 30 hour curriculum incorporates classroom presentations and activities, home dialogue assignments and school community change projects.
