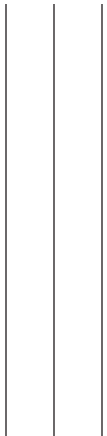

Understanding and Responding to the Sexual Behavior of Children

helps adults understand children's sexual behavior and respond in ways that will promote children's healthy sexual development. The training describes the continuum of sexual behavior from healthy to unhealthy, teaches adults how to recognize the difference, how to answer children's questions, and how to intervene and redirect behavior in order to help prevent child to child sexual abuse.

Completion of training in Understanding and Responding to the Sexual Behavior of Children can count toward Child Development/Protective Service training requirements for childcare providers. The training provides background information for further training in implementing the Care for Kids: Early Childhood Healthy Sexual Development and Abuse Prevention Curriculum in the early childhood education/care setting, as well as for foster parents and collaborating partners.

Understanding and Responding to the Sexual Behavior of Children is a Primary Perpetration Program developed by Gail Ryan, et al at the Kempe Children's Center, University of Colorado, Denver, Colorado.
